The Jurassic Coast covers a long stretch of coastline between East Devon and Dorset in the South of England. It is also a haven for Earth Sciences enthusiasts and fossil collectors with its geological history dating back to 185 million years ago. Expect some ascents/descents and ~16km walk.
